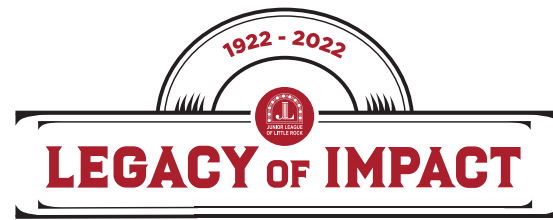

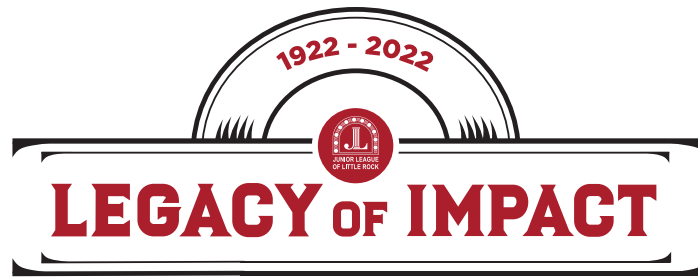


Junior League of Little Rock has had and continues to have profound involvement with beacons throughout the Capital City that positively impact the quality of life for all citizens.
